## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, An invitation was extended by the National Congress of American Indians and the American Friends Service Committee to a conference on proposed field projects in Arizona, such conference to be held in Pasadena, California beginning February 28 and ending March 2, 1952,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the Chairman is hereby authorized to attend such a conference beginning February 28 through March 2, 1952,

PROVIDED, That in accordance with Resolution No. 563, per diem is hereby authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on March 7, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 15 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
