RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 609

WHEREAS, On July 7, 1946 the Papago Council by Resolution No. 293 provided that the expenditures for the Tribal prisoners and the Tribal Court be from I.I.M. Account PT-8, Papago Tribe, Court Fund, instead of from Account PT-7, Emergency Fund, and

WHEREAS, The income of the Tribal Court from various court fines on cases tried in the Papago Tribal Court has been sufficient to support the operations of the Tribal Court, inspite of the increased activities, though the amount received into PT-8, Court Fund, has varied from month to month, and

whereas, It is expected that PT-8, Court Fund, will increase before the end of Fisch. Year 1952, but at the present time when there is a need fromaking improvements to the Tribal Court and its operations through the physical improvements to the Papago Tribal Court and the revision of the Law and Order Code of the Papago Triba, which will require numerous mostings of the Law and Order Committee of the Papago Council, it is the feeling of the Papago Council that the PT-8 funds should be supplemented to insure the successful completion of the improvements to the Papago Tribal Court and its operations,

THEREFORE EE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPISO COUNCIL, That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to transfer \$1,000.00 from Account PT-1, General Fund, to Account PT-2, Papago Tribe, Court Fund, for the expenditures of the Papago Tribal Court for the balance of the Fiscal Year 1952.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1752, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe retified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
