RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 610

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 366 of the Papago Council provides that Committee members shall serve for indefinite terms, at the pleasure of the Papago Council, but that failure to attend three consecutive meetings shall be grounds for automatic dismissal, and

WHEREAS, Louis Harvey has failed to attend three consecutive meetings of the Business Committee of the Papago Council thus automatically creating a vacancy in the membership of that Committee,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAFAGO COUNCIL, That Ralph Johnson of Sells be appointed to fill the vacancy in the membership of the Business Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
