RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, Lopez Havier of Pisinemo Village has applied for a loan of \$200.00, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Ordinance No. 20 of the Papago Council, the Loan Board has recommended to the Papago Council that the loan be approved.

THEREFORE WE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the lean application of Lopez Havier be and is hereby approved.

PROVIDED, That said loan shall be payable within 6 months from the date of said loan at an interest rate of 5%, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the said 5% rate of interest shall apply to the whole amount of \$200.00 for the specified period of 6 months, and

PROVIDED FINALLY, That the interest for the entire period of 6 months shall be payable within one (1) month from the date of receipt of said loan.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by the Papago Council Ordinance No. 20 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on March 7, 1944 pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
