HETELAS, Tho VAYA CHIN, EARA, VESTANA CATTLE ASSOCIATION has submitted its Articles of Association and By-Laws to the Papago Council for review and such Articles of Association and By-Laws have been reviewed and found satisfactory,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That it hareby approves the Articles of Association and By-Laws of the VAYA CHIN, KAKA, VENTANA CATTLE ASSOCIATION.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jeneary 6, 1737, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
