WHEREAS; Thomas A. Segundo, Chairman of the Papago Council, has accepted a scholarship to the INSTITUTE ON AMERICAN INDIAN ASSIMILATION to be held in Washington D. C. and has made formal application to the Papago Council for annual leave,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL; That, in accordance with Resolution No. 615, the application of Thomas A. Segundo for annual leave is hereby approved, such leave to begin on May 7 and end on May 14, 1952.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 Against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by the Papago Council Resolution No. 615 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on March 7, 1944 pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
