RESOLUTION
OF
PART OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the above resolution, Res. No. 621
was passed by the Papago Council.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the sum of \$12,250.00 be appropriated from the General Fund of the Papago Tribe, Account PT-1, for the ordinary expenses of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1953, to be transferred to the accounts listed below in the amounts set forth, and to be expended as authorized therein, on and after July 1, 1952.

PROVIDED: That at the end of the Fiscal Year 1953 any unobligated balance in any of the below listed budget accounts shall revert to the General Fund PT-1.

<u>TO</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>
PT-2 For travel and meeting expenses for delegates and officers of the Papago Council in attending regular and special meetings of the council, whether or not there be a quorum, to be expended under authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council. PROVIDED, That only mileage allowance be paid when there is not a quorum present	\$3,000.00
PT-3 For stationary, office supplies and equipment, telephone and telegraph tolls, postage, utilities, etc., to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer	650.00
PT-4 For salaries of Tribal employees, including Social Security taxes, Bond premium, lump sum payments, and promotion to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer	5,000.00
PT-5 For travel and meeting expenses for Council Committees and officers of the Papago council in attending Committee meetings as it may be necessary for them to attend in the performance of their authorized duties, to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer	1,500.00
PT-5A For Tribal truck operation, maintenance and repairs, to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary & Treasurer	600.00
PT-6 For maintenance, repairs and improvements to the Tribal Community Building, to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary & Treasurer	700.00
PT-7 For miscellaneous purposes not included in the above accounts, to be expended only under resolution of the Papago Council	800.00
	TOTAL = \$12,250.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the above appropriation be adopted as the budget of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1953.

The foregoing resolution was on June 27, 1951, duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.






