

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal cash account records have not been current since the beginning of the Fiscal Year 1951 and it is essential to the Tribe that they be brought up to date, and

WHEREAS, In order to bring the accounts up to date it is necessary to hire outside accounting help involving considerable research and survey of accounting records, and

WHEREAS, The Chairman of the Papago Council was on June 27, 1952 authorized to have this accounting work done,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That payment therefor in the amount of \$300.00 is hereby authorized from Account PT-1, General Fund.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1926, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1927, pursuant to Sec. 14 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 584). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
