RESOLUTION OF TIES PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHIREAS, Joseph Martin was on January 1, 1952 appointed Tribal Herd Foreman at a salary of \$175.00 per month such salary to be paid from the Annual Budget of the Papago Tribal Herd, Fond PT-9, and

WHITEAS, Joseph Martin has served well in the position of Tribal Hord Foreman.

THANKFORE IN IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the salary of Joseph Martin, Tribal Herd Foreman, be raised from (175.00 to (200.60 per month, such salary to be paid from the Annual Budget of the Papago Tribal Her , Fund PT-9C, and

DE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Joseph Martin give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000),

" FROVIDED, That the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from the Amnual Budget of the Papago Tribal Herd, Famil PT-90.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, daily exacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Go moil, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jamusry 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (13 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission of the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
