

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 633

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 593 states, "That Thomas B. Throssell be recommended to the Arizona State Livestock Sanitary Board for appointment as State Livestock Inspector and Peace Officer; Provided, that one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the salary per month be paid from PT-4, Papago Tribe, Tribal Salaries, and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be paid by the State of Arizona"; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 593 further states, "That Thomas B. Throssell give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) and to the State in the amount required by law; Provided, that the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from PT-3"; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 632 provides salary, Per Diem, promotion and Lump Sum Payment for the Papago Livestock Inspector and further provides payment for Bond Premium for the Livestock Inspector.

WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That paragraph 6 of Resolution No. 593 be amended to read as follows: "That one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the salary per month be paid from PT-104, Papago Tribal Livestock Operation, and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be paid by the State of Arizona"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That paragraph 8 of Resolution No. 593 be amended to read as follows: "That the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from PT-104, Papago Tribal Livestock Operation".

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (c) 3 (c), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 924). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
