WHEREAS, The 1950 Chevrolet $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup now being used by the Papago Tribal Loan Board Manager has reached the point in use where the operation, maintenance and repair cost will greatly increase,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, That a new 1952 Chevrolet, Model 3104-CCEX, $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup be purchased to replace the 1950 Chevrolet, $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup now in use.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
