

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 638

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 637 authorized the purchase of a new 1952 Chevrolet, Model 3104-CCBX,  $\frac{1}{2}$  Ton Pickup, and

WHEREAS, Such a Pickup has now been purchased,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That payment in the amount of \$1794.44 be made to O'RIELLY MOTOR COMPANY of Tucson, Arizona for the new 1952 Chevrolet, Model 3104-CCBX,  $\frac{1}{2}$  Ton Pickup, Motor No. ~~XXXX~~ 406430, Serial No. 20KPF 4190,

PROVIDED, That the payment of the above mentioned Pickup shall be made from Account PT-1, General Fund, and

FURTHER PROVIDED, That adequate insurance coverage shall be obtained, the premium of which insurance coverage to be paid from PT-12A, Papago Tribal Loan Board Operation, and

FURTHER PROVIDED, That the payment of operation, maintenance and repairs shall be made from Account PT-12A, Papago Tribal Loan Board Operation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 964). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
