

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 639

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 637 authorized the purchase of a new 1952 Chevrolet, Model 3104-01EX, $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup, and

WHEREAS, The new Pickup has now been received for use by the Papago Loan Board Manager, and

WHEREAS, The Topawa Cooperative Store has offered to buy the 1950 Chevrolet, $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup formerly owned by the Papago Tribal Loan Board Manager,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That authorization is hereby given for the sale of the 1950 Chevrolet, $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup and the Chairman instructed to negotiate with the Topawa Cooperative for the sale of the 1950 Chevrolet $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Pickup, Motor No. REA1104873, Serial No. 20HPJ-8518.

The foregoing resolution was on July 11, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on December 12, 1936, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 904). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the reconsideration by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
