

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 640

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be instructed to request the Commissioner of Indian Affairs to allot two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) from the non-interest bearing and any other funds being held to the credit of the Papago Tribe in the U.S. Treasury, and

AS IT IS LIVED, That these funds shall be expended by the Superintendent upon the authorization of the officers of the Papago Council, for the purposes of supplementing the Fiscal Year 1953 Budget of the Papago Council, as approved by Resolution No. 621 of the Papago Council.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 10 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
