THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res.. No. 642

WHEREAS, Robert A. Pablo, Tribal Caretaker and Jailer, submitted his resignation effective at the end of business day June 16, 1952 which resignation was on June 27, 1952 accepted by the Papago Council, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council by Resolution No. 625 appointed Lewis Thomas to serve as acting Caretaker and Jailer until such a time as the Papago Council shall appoint a regular Tribal Caretaker and Jailer,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Norbert Leonard of Cold Fields be and is hereby appointed Tribal Caretaker and Jailer at a base salary of \$125.00 per month and shall serve in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 641 and Resolution No. 615.

The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 10 for and 5 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e), 3 (a), (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
