

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 643

WHEREAS, John M. Harlow, Landscape architecture of Tucson, Arizona was hired by the Papago Council to design appropriate landscaping around the Papago Tribal Soldier's memorial, and

WHEREAS, The Landscaping has now been completed,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the sum of \$402.99 be paid John M. Harlow, Landscape Contractor for the services rendered and materials used for the landscaping project.

PROVIDED, That of the total payment of \$402.99 to be made to John M. Harlow, Landscape Contractor, \$86.59 shall be paid from account PT-19, Papago Tribe, Soldier's Memorial; and \$316.40 shall be paid from Account PT-7, Papago Tribe, Miscellaneous Fund.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That payment for the repairs to the Soldier's memorial monument be and are hereby authorized.

PROVIDED, That such payment shall be made from Account PT-7, Papago Tribe, Miscellaneous Fund, upon presentation of certified invoice by John M. Harlow, Landscape contractor.


The foregoing resolution was on August 1, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission of the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and by-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


