RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Ros. No. 648

WHEREAS, Section IX of Ordinance No. 22 of the Papago Council provides for a bonded clark to handle all clerical work connected with the handling of brands, registration, meetings, etc., and

WHEREAS, There is now a vacancy in the position of Livestock Clerk.

THEREFORE BE IT RECOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Evelyn Lopes of Vamori Village be appointed to the position of Livestock Clerk at a salary of \$125.00 per month, such appointment to be effective September 1, 1952,

PROVIDED, That such salary be paid from PT-10A, Papago Livestock Operation, in accordance with the annual budget of the Papago Livestock Board.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and by-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
