

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 649

WHEREAS, Ramona J. Garcia has submitted her resignation to the Papago Council from the position of Papago Tribal Court Clerk, thus creating a vacancy in that position,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Katherine Hendricks of Wamori Village be appointed to the position of Papago Tribal Court Clerk at a salary of \$125.00 per month, such appointment to be effective September 1, 1952,

PROVIDED, That such salary be paid from FF-24, Papago Tribal Court Operation in accordance with the annual budget of the Papago Tribal Court.

The foregoing resolution was on September 12, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), 3 (a), (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Sec. 15 of the Act of June 15, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


