RESOLUTI SOME OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

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Res. No. 650

WHEREAS: The Papago Council on August 1, 1952 by its Resolution No. 634 authorized the filing of an application for a loan from the Revolving Credit Fund of the Indian Bureau up to the amount of \$40,000.00 and further authorized and instructed the Chairman and the Secretary of the Papago Council to:

- (1) Prepare and execute such application and offer the following security,
 - (a) Assignment of all income and
 - (b) General Assignment;
- (2) To obligate the Tribe up to this amount under such conditions as the said officers may deem proper;
- (3) To execute and deliver to the Secretary of the Interior or his authorized representative such written instruments as may be required as evidence of any loan made pursuant to the terms of Resolution No. 634, and

WHEREAS: The provisions of Resolution No. 634 have been fully complied with and a Commitment Order for a Lean of Revolving credit Funds from the United States to The Papago Tribe has been received notifying the Papago Council that its application has been approved and a lean granted for a total of \$40,000.00 to be advanced and repaid in accordance with submitted schedules,

PROVIDED: That before it is entitled to receive any advances the Papago Tribe shall comply with all the conditions contained in the Commitment Order and the applications,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That the Commitment Order for a loan of Revolving Credit Funds from the United States to The Papago Tribe for a total of \$40,000.00 be accepted and the Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby authorized and instructed to execute the acceptance.

The foregoing resolution was on the 30th day of September, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2(a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on Becember 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jameary 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act 2 June 18, 1934 (48 State 984e) Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
