RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 653

WHEREAS, The National Congress of American Indians, in line with its program to help American Indians find salf-help, is sponsoring a conference on American Indian Development, and

WHEREAS, The Indian Tribes of the State of Arizona have been invited to participate in the conference which is to be held in Phoenix from October 6 to 17, 1952,

THEREFORE HE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and the Secretary & Treasurer of the Papago Council be appointed as a committee and authorized to attend the conference on American Indian Development as a delegation from the Papago Tribe.

PROVIDED, That the Chairman shall be authorized to select other delegates in the event that any of the delegation should find it impossible to attend the conference or if in the opinion of the Chairman it should appear necessary to appoint additional delegates, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That allowances for Per Diem and lodging be paid in advance in accordance with Resolution Nos. 621 and 394 for the period of attendance at the American Indian Development conference.

The foregoing resolution was on September 26, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (h8 Stat. 984) and Resolution No. 621. Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
