

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 7

Should be no. 654

WHEREAS, Section 2 (d), Article 5 of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona states that: "The Council shall have the power to advise with the Secretary of the Interior and Congress as to its desires and wishes on all appropriation estimates and Federal projects for the three Papago Reservations and for the benefit of the Papago Tribe, and as to monies spent for such purposes", and

WHEREAS, The Division of Forestry and Grazing of the Papago Agency has submitted to the Papago Council a report covering the late Range Water Supply Rehabilitation and Development Program proposed for the Papago Reservation to justify the \$150,000 appropriation as a recurring item for the next fiscal year, 1954 and to recommend the items to be accomplished during the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, The report has been given in detail as to water development and rehabilitation and also indicating for how long the \$150,000 should be a recurring item including a table which can be projected over the years to show what progress can be expected.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That it hereby concurs with the Water Development and Rehabilitation Program submitted by the Division of Forestry and Grazing of the Papago Agency.

PROVIDED, That any comments and decisions to be made by the Papago Council shall be transmitted to the Area Office prior to October 15, 1952 for the consideration of the Area Office and the District Office.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 1 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (d), Article 5 of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 11, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 1, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 574). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
