BE If FURTHER EXSOLVED: That the said Papago Tribal Stone Enterprise shall be operated in accordance with the attached Plan of Operation of The Papago Tribe's own authority and responsibility.

PROVIDED: That the Plan of Operation may be amended as experience with the plan necessitates it.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, purcuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (f) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Recenter 12, 1935 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6. 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (bb Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
