

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 656

WHEREAS: To this date it has not been possible for the Papago Council to hire a Manager of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise; and

WHEREAS: It appears necessary that a Manager should be hired before the Covered Wells and the Pisinemo stores are actually purchased, in order that he may assist with the inventories, etc, and be ready to assume charge of the enterprise immediately; and

WHEREAS: Irwin W. Flood has been hired by the Papago Tribal Office to investigate and study the Covered Wells and Pisinemo Trading Posts and to devise a commercial bookkeeping and Accounting system for adoption by the Papago Council;

THHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That payment at the rate of \$1.50 per hour shall be made to Irwin W. Flood for his services to the Papago Council;

PROVIDED: That such payment shall be made from Account PA-1, General Fund, and in accordance with a certified time sheet.

The foregoing resolution was on October 24, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on Dec. 12, 1926, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jan. 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1904, (38 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
