THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 661

WHEREAS: "Resolution No. 613 of the Papago Council inadvertently omitted the word "Kaka" in referring to the livestock owners of Vaya Chin, Kaka and Ventana Villages;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL; That Resolution No. 613 be and is hereby revised to read as follows:

WHEREAS, The livestock owners of Vaya Chin, Kaka, and Ventana Villages in Hickiwan District on the Papa go Indian Reservation in Arizona, have voluntarily associated together to promote their social welfare in the economic capital stock, and

WHEREAS, The VAYA CHIN, KAKA, VENTANA CATTLE ASSOCIATION has submitted its Articles of Association and By-Laws to the Papago Council for review and such Articles of Association and By-Laus have been reviewed and found satisfactory,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That it hereby approves the Articles of Association and By-Laws of the VAYA CHIE, KAKA, VERTANA CATTLE ASSOCIATION.

The foregoing resolution was on November 21, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and O against by the Papa go Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
