## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: On October 24, 1952, the Papago Tribe approved the Plan of Operation for the Papago Tribul Store Enterprise which Plan of Operation was on November 13, 1952, approved by the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs subject to certain conditions which conditions were accepted by Resolution No. 660 of The Papago Council on November 21, 1952; and

MERELS: Section III, 3 of the Plan of Spurction for the Parago Tribal Store Enterprise provides; that the store manager shall be employed under a written contract approved by the Board of Directors, The Papago Council and The Area Director, which contract shall include specific conditions of the Education employment including compensation, surely bend, leave, addition duties, provisions that the manager shall abide by the Plan of Operation and liquidated damages, if any, to be included in the said contract and, provides further; that the presides on the manager's surety bond may be paid by the store and his bond may be included in a "blanket" bond;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PARK CO COUNCIL: That Er. Arthur B. Powers of Tiger, Arisona be employed as manager of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise and that Hr. Curtis M. Homey be employed as assistant manager of the Papago Tribal Store amorphise.

PROVIDED: That written contracts shall be executed between Arthur B. Powers, Curtis M. Bunney and the Papago Tribs, which written contracts shall be approved by the Board of Directors of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise, the Papago Council and the Area Director; and

PROVIDED FUETHER: That specific conditions of the managers' apployment including compensation, surely bond, loave, additional duties, provisions that the managers abide by the Plan of Operation and liquidated damages, if any, shall be included in the contracts; and

PROVIDED FURTHER: That the premiums on the managers' surety buses shall be paid by the Tribal Store Enterprise and their bonds way be included in a "blanket" bond; and

PROVIDED PURTHER: That the employments of Arthur B. Powers as Manager of the Papago Tribal Store Laterprise and Curtis H. Rush Tribal Store Enterprise Shari be effective as of December 1, 1952.

## REMOTHER

FROWIDED FINALLY: That this resolution shall be effective as of November 21, 1952.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1952, duly enected by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Council parament to authority vested in it by Sec. 2, (c), (f), of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Gerebery of the Interior on Jeffusry 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
