

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 665

WHEREAS: The Papago Council on November 21, 1952 employed Arthur B. Powers as Manager of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise, such employment being effective as of December 1, 1952, and also employed Curtis M. Busney as Assistant Manager of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise, such employment to be effective as of December 1, 1952; and

WHEREAS: Delays have been encountered on the advance of funds which were applied for from the revolving Credit Funds of the Bureau of Indian Affairs so that there are at the present time no funds available to pay the salaries of Messrs. Arthur B. Powers and Curtis M. Busney whose employment contracts provide that the first salary payments shall be made 30 days from the effective day of the employment contract;

THEREFORE BE IT REQUESTED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL: That the payment of the salaries of Arthur B. Powers and Curtis M. Busney for the month of December are hereby authorized and approved and shall be made from Account PT-1, General Fund, provided; that Account PT-1, General Fund, shall be reimbursed from the funds of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise at the earliest convenience of the Papago Tribal Store Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Tribe, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
