

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Res. No. 667

WHEREAS, It is the feeling of the Papago Council that it would be for the best interest of the Papago Council and the Papago Tribe that Joseph Martin, Papago Tribal Board Manager, be terminated from his present position.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That Joseph Martin be terminated from the position of Tribal Board Manager, such termination to be effective as of December 31, 1952, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the lump sum payment for any accrued annual leave is hereby authorized and approved.

THE foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1952, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (e) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 2, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 10, 1936 (49 Stat. 706). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is not subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior.
