

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL.

Res. No. 1029

WHEREAS, Resolution 1001 of July 18, 1958, authorized the payment of \$178.00 for 14 days annual leave in the calendar years 1956-7, which the Chairman, Mark Marmel, was unable to take during that period, and

WHEREAS, this special payment was granted because the Council felt the Chairman had put in long hours of faithful performance of his duties as Tribal Chairman, and . . .

WHEREAS, the Council feels the former Chairman, Mark Marmel, should also receive a similar payment for 13 days annual leave he did not receive in the 1958 calendar year.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that in this additional case, Resolution 615, Section II-B, be amended to authorize payment to Mark Marmel, former Tribal Chairman, of \$165.36, the amount of salary represented by 13 days of annual leave which he was unable to take in the calendar year 1958.

The foregoing resolution was approved on February 6, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
