RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGOSCOUNCIL

RES. NO. 1032

WEREAS, At a special meeting of the Sells District Council held March 6, 1959, at which a quorum was present, the Council unanimously agreed to grant permission to issue a permit to Trico Electric Cooperative Inc., of Tucson, Arizona for a power line right of way from the present Trico power line just south of the Big Fields turnoff on the old Sells-Ajo road, and extend along the south side of the Big Fields Road to the new well site located in the s.w. quarter of Section 30, T. 17 S., R. 3 E., G&SEM, Arizona, a distance of approximately 5.7 miles, and

WHENEAS, The power line is needed for the operation of a new well which will furnish water to the Sells community, the new Papago Indian Respital, and the Papago Agency;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be granted permission to issue such right of way, and that the Chairman of the Council is authorized to sign on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (a) & (c) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (43 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
