WHEREAS, The Tribal Herd manager wishes to transfer this amount from the bull bond account to the Tribal Herd account for the purchasing of new bulls for the herd, and

WHEREAS, The Council believes this is desirable because it will help maintain the quality of the Tribal Herd;

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it request the Papago Agency to transfer the sum of \$980.00, the amount of forfeited bull bond deposits as shown above, from the bull bond deposit account to the Tribal Herd account, with the understanding that this amount will be used for the purchase of breeding bulls for the Tribal Herd.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
