RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1034

WHERMAS, On December 18 the Papago Council approved a lease to Max Morris on Tract 62 of the Mast Chuichu project, and Tract 71, to Joe C. Juan, but failed to pass a Resolution to this effect:

THEREFORE, LET IT HE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that these two leases be approved in accordance with signed agreements with the lessees, copies of which are being furnished to the Agency and which list the terms and conditions as approved by the Council on December 18.

The foregoing resolution was on March 6, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 22 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12; 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937; pursuant to Section 1 6 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 State. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
