

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

REC. NO. 1039

WHEREAS, At present postal service for Indians living on the west side of the Reservation is poor, and

WHEREAS, The Council understands a ~~request~~ is being made to have a post-office established at the Y, where the road to Lukeville and Sonoita joining State Highway 86.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it support a request for such a Post Office, which it believes will better postal service to Hichitan, Gila Yo, and Picurino Districts.

The foregoing resolution was on April 3, 1939, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 904). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its enactment.
