RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1040

WHENEAS, It is the understanding of the Papago Council that Mark Menuel has been appointed regular judge by the Eureau of Indian Affairs, but that his appointment has not yet been submitted to the Council for approval, and

WHEREAS, The Council recognizes that the Eurosu has the right to appoint a regular judge, but in accordance with the Papago Law Order Code this appointment is subject to approval by majority vote of the Council, and

WHEREAS, The Council believes that a regular judge should be in good health so he will be able to fulfill all the responsibilities of his office, including being present regularly whenever Court is acheduled, and

WHEREAS, The Council recognizes Mark Marmel's ability, and his long experience in tribal matters, and ordinarily would not object to him being proposed by the Pureau as judge, or for any other position, but it believes the present state of his health is so poor that it doubts if he can perform the duties of judge satisfactorily at this time.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it request the Bureau to withdraw the appointment of Mark Manuel for regular judge, and permit the Council to present to the Superintendent the names of individuals who the Council considers qualified, and able, to act as regular judge, with the further request that the Superintendent select one of these candidates who he believes will perform the duties of regular judge in a satisfectory manner.

The foregoing resolution was on April 3, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against by the Papago Council during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (f) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6 1957, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the Late of its enactment.
