

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1042

WHEREAS, In a letter of March 18, 1959, the Chuichu Farmers Association has requested a lease on Tracts #35 (7.4 acres) and 36 (7.4 acres) of the old project, stating in their application that these tracts have been abandoned, and

WHEREAS, The Chuichu Farmers Association have requested the use of these two tracts without charge because they do not have sufficient capital to pay lease fee, but are trying to make more money for their capital account so they can again operate like they used to.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chuichu Farmers Association be granted a lease on the above land without charge on a year to year basis provided that the Chuichu Farmers Association agree to pay the full water charges on the land used.

The foregoing resolution was on April 3, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 21 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
