WHEREAS, The Baboquivari District Council has submitted its Resolution No. 8 covering its proposed budget for the fiscal year 1960, and

WHENEAS, The District had a balance of \$3,012.35 as of June 30, 1959, which is in the IIM account, and anticipates its revenue during the 1960 fiscal year at £1,025.00, and

WIMBEAS, The Papago Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Eaboquivari District budget for the 1960 fiscal year be approved as follows:

That the Treasurer of Baboquivari District Council be authorised to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified, and that the Treasurer of the Papago Council be authorized to sign vouchers for payment of these orders against the Revolving Fund of the Papago Tribe, IIM account PT-1F, and

Provided that any monies budgeted but not used for items 1 to 6 may also be expended for mange improvements by resolution of the District Council.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 10, 1959 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3(a) of the Constitution of The Tribo ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Sec. of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934(48 Stat)
