

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1056

WHEREAS, The Pisinimo District Council has submitted its Resolution covering its proposed budget for the fiscal year 1960, and

WHEREAS, The District had a balance of \$992.35 as of June 30, 1959, which is in the IIM account, and anticipates its revenue during the 1960 fiscal year at \$500.00, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has considered the proposed budget and finds it reasonable and to the benefit of the District.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Pisinimo District budget for the 1960 fiscal year be approved as follows:

1. For maintenance and operation of walls in following villages:

Pisinimo, Santa Cruz, and Dirt Dunn . . . . . \$ 300.00

2. To repair District fence and build fences around water holes at San Simon Village . . . . .

200.00  
\$ 500.00, and

That the Treasurer of Pisinimo District Council be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purposes in the amounts specified, and that the Treasurer of the Papago Council be authorized to sign vouchers for payment of these orders against the Revolving Fund of the Papago Tribe, IIM account PT-1U.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 10, 1959, with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).
