

RESOLUTION OF THE

PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1057

WHEREAS, Pan Tak Village has a credit in its village account of \$205.91, and

WHEREAS, It needs this money to pay for roundup supplies, and has submitted its request to the Schuk Toak District Council for approval, and

WHEREAS, At a meeting on May 17, 1959, the Schuk Toak District Council approved this request by a vote of 9 to 0, a quorum being present, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has considered the purpose of these proposed expenditures by Pan Tak Village and considers it to reasonable.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED That Pan Tak village be authorized to spend the balance of \$205.91 in its village account for the purchase of round-up supplies during the 1960 fiscal year, and that an authorized official of the Schuk Toak District Council be authorized to sign purchase orders for the above purpose in the amounts specified, and that the Treasurer of the Papago Council be authorized to sign vouchers for payment of these orders against the account of the Pan Tak Village.

The foregoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 10, 1959 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3(a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
