

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1659

WHEREAS, The resignation of Joann Garcia has left a vacancy in the position of Chief Clerk of the Law and Order Department, and

WHEREAS, JoAnn Harvey has been serving as Assistant Clerk for more than a year and is familiar with the clerical work which must be done in Tribal Court and in the Office, and

WHEREAS, Clara Acosta has applied for the position of Assistant Clerk, having previously worked in the Law and Order Department for 4 months, and recently completed a course at a business college in Phoenix.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that JoAnn Harvey be appointed as Chief Clerk of the Law and Order Department, effective July 1, 1959, at a salary of \$195.00 per month, and Clara Acosta be appointed Assistant Clerk effective July 1, at a salary of \$150.00 per month.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 10, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) & (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
