

WHEREAS, Pima County is planning the construction of a road called Herman Road along the north side of the San Xavier Reservation, a distance of 11.5 miles along the Reservation line, and

WHEREAS, Pima County wishes a Right of Way 150 feet wide for this road and is asking the Tribe to donate one-half of the R/W which will be a strip 75 feet wide for the full distance of 11.5 miles, making a total of approximately 104.5 acres, or approximately 9.45 acres per mile of Tribal land which the County wishes the Tribe to donate, which is a large amount of land, and

WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council, at a meeting on June 9, 1959 passed a Resolution authorizing the granting of the Right of Way provided compensation is made for the land used for this purpose, and authorized the Chairman of the Papago Council to negotiate the terms and conditions under which the R/W will be authorized, subject to approval by the District Council before final arrangements are made.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED That a Right of Way on Tribal land 75 feet wide be authorized for the construction of Herman Road provided payment is made for the land used for this purpose, and The Chairman of the Papago Council is delegated to negotiate the terms and conditions of the Right of Way, which the San Xavier District Council must approve before final arrangements are made.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on July 10, 1959 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 2 (a), (c) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (43 Stat.)
