

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

REC. NO. 1064

WHEREAS, There is a balance of \$4,106.90 in the Law and Order fund PT-1B, which is a surplus of income of expenses for the 1959 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, This amount should be transferred to the General Fund, PT-1A.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the amount of \$4,106.90 be transferred from the Law and Order account PT-1B to the General Fund account PT-1A.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 18 for and 0 against by the Papago Council, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 924). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
