

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 3065

WHEREAS, D. O. Norton and Sons have requested permission to remove from 7,000 to 10,000 cu. yards of material from the Sells wash to be used for concrete in construction of the new hospital, and


WHEREAS, The Sells District Council at a meeting held July 9 approved this request and set a price of 7¢ per cu. yard for the material.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to issue a permit to D. O. Norton and Sons to remove 7,000 to 10,000 cu. yards of material from the Sells wash as requested at a price of 7¢ per cu. yard, one-half to be paid to the Tribal Council and one-half to the Sells District, D. O. Norton and Sons to keep an accurate record of the material used.


The foregoing Resolution was on July 10, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 904). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.


