

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1069

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs is not able to adequately repair and maintain the roads on the San Xavier Indian Reservation due to the great distance involved in transporting road equipment from the Papago Agency at Sells, and

WHEREAS, Pima County Highway Department is in a better position to service such roads and is willing to assume the responsibility of maintaining and repairing the roads provided Pima County has the necessary rights of way as County funds cannot be expended on roads not within the county highway system, and

WHEREAS, Better roads on the San Xavier Indian Reservation will benefit the community as a whole, and

WHEREAS, The rights of way will traverse the following parcels of tribal lands:

East 60 feet of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23; South and West 30 feet of $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, East 30 feet of $S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$, and East 30 feet of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27; South 30 feet extending approximately 700 feet West from East boundary line of $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28; all in Township 15 South, Range 13 East, G&SMM, Arizona.

WHEREAS, The San Xavier District Council in a meeting July 12, 1959, at which a quorum was present, did authorize the Transfer of the Rights of Way.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to grant rights of way over tribal lands as indicated above to Pima County, without payment of damages, with the further right to transfer the rights of way by assignment, grant or otherwise, provided that such rights of way are for roads only and do not include Right of way for power lines, telephone lines, or for any other purpose unless first approved by the Papago Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on August 7, 1959, with a vote of 20 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 2 (a) & (c) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
