

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1071

WHEREAS, The East Chuichu group of farmers have asked the Tribe to give them the old TD-14 now at Chuichu which is the property of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council does not feel it should give away equipment of this kind, but should attempt to get any salvage value it can out of it.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the TD-14 be sold for the best possible price and the money received from the sale be put in the general fund of the Tribe, PT-1A.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 7, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 20 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
