

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO RESOLUTION

RES. NO. 1072

WHEREAS, F. C. Blackman, 52 West Delano, Tucson, has made a written application to lease 1 acre of land 105' X 110' immediately next to the land being leased by Ernest Radolph on the west side, and

WHEREAS, The land will be used to park trucks used in hauling silica from the George Freeman operation to Ajo, also to locate one or two house trailers, to erect a small building to house parts for maintaining the trucks, and possibly to put up a small water tank, for which he will pay a rental fee of \$50.00 a year, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Blackman's application was considered and approved by the Cu Achi District Council at a meeting held September 6, 1959 at which a quorum was present.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that Mr. Blackman's application be approved and the Papago Agency be asked to have the land appraised, and the necessary papers prepared so the lease can be signed and put into effect.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 11, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against by the Papago Council during a meeting at which a quorum was present pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V, and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
