

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1074

WHEREAS, JoAnn Harvey has submitted her resignation from her position in the Law and Order Department effective September 4, in order to take a job with the Public Health Service, and

WHEREAS, She has a total of \$68.63 due her, which includes 29 hours of annual leave.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that JoAnn Harvey's resignation be accepted and the Treasurer be authorized to pay her the amount due her, including her annual leave.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 11, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
