

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

REC. NO. 1076

WHEREAS, There is a need for financial assistance by young Papago men and women to further their education, and

WHEREAS, There is an Education Committee functioning that considers all requests for education loans and/or grants, and approves or disapproves them, this Committee consisting of all Tribal Employees, with Thomas E. Throssell acting as Chairman, and

WHEREAS, There is a balance of \$265.40 in the Papago Tribal Education fund, PT-1W, on deposit in the Papago Tribe revolving funds in the local depository, and

WHEREAS, Prior to the enactment of this Resolution there was an urgent need for financial assistance by applicants preparing for school beginning in September, 1959, and the Papago Agency was requested by the Education Committee to pay five Tribal Vouchers for education loans, and

WHEREAS, The fiscal year 1960 Tribal Budget made no provisions for the disbursement of the Papago Tribal Education Funds, which are derived from the repayments of delinquent loans owed the Tribe by Tribal members.

THEFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it confirm the Education Committee and its present membership, that it be instructed to set up conditions governing loans, that after considering requests for education loans and/or grants, it be authorized to approve them or disapprove them, provided that when an education loan is granted, there be an agreement signed by the person to whom the loan is made, in which the repayment schedule is specified, and that upon final approval of any loan the Committee be authorized to make a written request to the Papago Agency to disburse funds, the request to be attached to a properly executed tribal voucher. Also that the provisions of this Resolution be effective August 14, 1959.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 11, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 19 for and 0 against by the Papago Council at a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) & (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
