

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1077

WHEREAS, Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc. has been asked by Tribal members in various communities on the Reservation to extend its power lines to these communities so the people can be supplied with electricity, and

WHEREAS, These additional communities that Trico is planning to serve include Gu Komelik and Anagam in Sif Oidak District, Santa Rosa Village, Ali Oidak, and Covered Wells in Cu Achi District, Vemori in Chukut Kuk District, and Big Fields in Sells District, and

WHEREAS, Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc., has made arrangements to serve the people in the villages who have requested electric service, and those who have not asked for it now can get it at a later date by making application for the service, and

WHEREAS, It will be of great benefit to the Papago people to have electricity in their homes.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to grant a Right of Way to Trico Electric Cooperative Inc. in accordance with applicable government regulations, so that Trico can put up the necessary transmission lines to supply electricity to Papago members living in the villages mentioned above, this Right of Way to be 30 feet wide and approximately 30 miles long, running from the Reservation line east of Komelik, then to Gu Komelik village through Anagam, Santa Rosa Village, to Covered Wells, plus such service lines as are necessary to serve homes and other installations along the route, the lines to be located as described in maps of alignment to be prepared by Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 25, 1959, duly enacted by a vote of 9 for, 2 against, and 5 not voting during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 2 (c) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 904).
