RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1079

WHEREAS, The members of the East Chuichu group of farmers wish to buy the old TD14 tractor belonging to the Tribe, this tractor presently being torn down, and

WHEREAS, Tractor dealers in Casa Grande won't buy the tractor outright but are willing to allow \$500 for it on a trade-in, and

WHEREAS, The East Chuichu group have offered to pay \$500 for the tractor, payment to be made from money received for crops.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it authorize the sale of the used TD14 tractor to the East Chuichu group for \$500, provided that the group first sign a written agreement in which all conditions of the sale and payment are specified, such agreement to be approved by the members of the East Chuichu group, the Tribal Chairman, and C. J. Higgins.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on September 25, 1959, with a vote of 16 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 2 (a) & Section 3 (b) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934, (49 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to the decision by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 3 of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
