RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 1007

WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District Council passed a Resolution on November 29, 1959 setting up the following budget to cover expenses for engine and well repair in the villages, for the purchase of gasoline, and for other expenses which the villages consider necessary

WHEREAS, The Schuk Toak District Council decided it would divide the money to be spent equally among the villages in the District for the first year and see how this works out, and if it does not work out satisfactorily, that a new way of setting up the budget will be considered, and

WHEREAS, It is understood the money spent will be used for the needs of the villages named, and any amount not used will be carried over to the next year and applied toward the amount budgeted for the village the following year, and

WHEREAS, Nestor Francisco was authorized to approve in writing any requests for expenditures by the villages.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the budget submitted by the Schuk Toak District Council be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 4, 1959 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat 984).
