

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

HES. NO. 1028

WHEREAS, The Hickman District Council passed a Resolution on December 1, 1959, setting up the following budget to cover expenses in its villages for gas and oil and other well repairs and for other expenses which each village considers necessary:

the \$1,077.16 to be shared equally between Vaya Chin, Ventana and Kaka until such time as a different distribution is decided upon at a later district meeting and a Resolution passed to that effect, and

WHEREAS, This leaves a balance of \$77.17 in present District funds which is reserved for use of Hickman Village, and

WHEREAS, It is understood that any amounts not used will be carried over to the following year and applied toward the amount budgeted for the village in that year, and

WHEREAS, Lawrence Lopez has been designated as Secretary-Treasurer and that he is authorized to approve in writing any requests for expenditures by the villages.

THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the budget submitted by the Hickman District be approved.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on December 7, 1959 with a vote of 18 for and 0 against during a meeting at which a quorum was present, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 3 (a) of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
